Events Package Overview

Current offers many types of events. Monthly main events will typically have a fee based on the expense of executing the event. Upgrading your membership by purchasing an events package entitles you to free admission to main events and will provide over a 50% cost savings vs. paying for each event individually. Employees of corporate members are NOT exempt from event fees; however, some employers will reimburse for event fees. Check with your employer regarding their policy. Employees of corporate members may choose to upgrade their membership independently by enrolling for the events package if their employer does not reimburse the cost of event fees.

2010 Events Package Rates

The 2010 events package is favorably priced at \$100.00 representing a 50% cost savings vs. paying for events individually. The rate is reduced by \$25.00 each calendar quarter and members may enroll at any time throughout the year even if they initially declined to enroll for the package.
