Tickets can be purchased in advance from any local U.S. Bank office or YMCA, the Cornerstone Ice Center, the Green Bay Area Chamber of Commerce, and the Aging and Disability Resource Center. Prices in advance are \$3 for adults and \$1 for children ages 5 – 18, and prices at the door will be \$5 for adults and \$3 for children ages 5 -18.
