The initial work is at the request of the U.S. Congress. The GAO is conducting a study on approaches other countries take to ensure fees associated with defined contribution (401K) plans are reasonable. Specifically, this study was requested by Rep. George Miller of the House Committee on Education and the Workforce. While recent regulations in the U.S. aim to increase the transparency of fees in defined contribution (401k) plans, concerns persist there are fees that can be charged that are poorly understood and difficult to monitor.
