ROLL YOUR WAY TO CAREERS ON WHEELS

Green Bay, Wis. (April 29, 2011) – Team up with Partners in Education of the Green Bay Chamber of Commerce and share your “wheels of success” as part of its Career on Wheels program. This unique opportunity allows elementary students to get hands-on career experience.

Participating businesses that employ the use of wheels – from farming machinery to hot dog stands – is encouraged to participate in the program being held at local participating schools.

How it works: Little to no preparation is required. You bring your wheels to one of the participating schools. Your set of wheels does not need to be exotic, and may even be more about the tools related to your career area. Students (3rd and 5th grade) in small groups will move from station to station every seven to 10 minutes, where exhibiting businesses will have time to talk about what they do on a day-to-day basis and how basic subjects such as math, reading, geography, etc., are applied in their respective professions.

The event allows students to meet positive career role models who highlight the importance of education in achieving their goals, while gaining awareness of potential careers.
