## CALLING ALL PAPER PILOTS – JOIN US FOR THE *SUPER* PAPER AIRPLANE TOSS

Green Bay, WI (Jan. 26, 2011) – Celebrate the Green Bay Packers’ journey to Super Bowl XLV at the 6<sup>th</sup> annual Paper Airplane Toss at the Lambeau Field Atrium on Saturday, Feb. 5, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. Be part of the Super Bowl excitement and let your kids be pilots for a day as they fly paper airplanes from the 2<sup>nd</sup> level landing to the atrium floor below.

“We are excited to hold our event at Lambeau Field and be part of the festive attitude surrounding the Packers’ historic run to Super Bowl XLV,” said Rebecca Deschane, Partners in Education youth development manager and coordinator of this fund-raising event. “The Great Paper Airplane Toss – which we’re renaming this year to the *Super* Paper Airplane Toss - is a great way for families of all ages to spend the day together in iconic Lambeau Field, recalling past Championship runs and gearing up for the big game on Sunday.”

This family-friendly event is open to pilots of all ages. Youth receive one free piece of paper for their first plane and each additional sheet only costs \$0.25. Solo flyers will compete in different age groups with the top two in each bracket awarded with \$50 savings bonds. The pilot with the longest overall flight will receive a \$100 dollar savings bond. This year’s event will also continue the Family vs. Family challenge at 2:30 p.m., where families in groups of four compete head-to-head with other families. The top two teams with the greatest combined distance will be awarded trophies. Families need to be registered to participate by 2 p.m. the day of the event.
