GOOD GOVERNMENT COUNCIL OF THE CHAMBER TAKE STANCE ON RECALL ELECTIONS

Green Bay, Wis.- (June 24, 2011) – The Good Government Council of the Green Bay Area Chamber of Commerce have taken a stance on the recall elections:

“The election cycle was put together by the state for good reasons. These recall elections represent nothing more than a waste of time, energy and money, and the Good Government Council of the Green Bay Area Chamber of Commerce does not support the recall campaign. Neither Republicans nor Democrats have committed illegal acts, malfeasance, or breach of ethics, which should be the true basis for recalls. Recalls are an extraordinary remedy and are not warranted in this situation. That said, we do urge members to do their civic duty and get out and vote in the recall election. Our hope is to work hand in hand with both parties to repair the recall system so that it cannot be used in such circumstances as we faced this year.”
