Mission

“Leadership Green Bay(LGB) develops and fosters leaders — providing education about local community’s strengths and opportunities, to encourage community stewardship.”

Program Elements

Participants meet one day per month, October through May, following a two-day overnight retreat in September. Programs focus on Green Bay’s local economy, education, local history and heritage, diversity and cultural awareness, human services, government and environment. In addition, small groups work on projects designed to enhance awareness of community problems, identify systems and methods to affect change, and develop project management, team and presentation skills. The groups meet on their own time outside Leadership Green Bay sessions.

SELECTION CRITERIA FOR LEADERSHIP GREEN BAY

The most important factor in selection is identifying those individuals most apt to utilize their leadership for the long-term benefit of the community. We strive to select a cross-section of participants from all sectors of the community. The basic criteria for achieving this selection are:

1. Select those individuals with a sincere commitment, motivation and interest to serve in the community.
2. Select those intending to seek public office, boards, commissions, or key volunteer leadership roles.
3. Select those with potential or existing opportunities for advancement to top leadership positions within their own organization, which may in turn play a significant role in the community.
4. Select individuals committed to their personal/career development.

COMMITMENT

If selected as a Leadership Green Bay participant, I understand that I am committing myself to involvement in the community upon graduation from the program. My name and contact information will be published annually in the LGB Directory for distribution to non-profit organizations. My name will also be given to community service organizations that are seeking volunteers.

ATTENDANCE:

In addition to the Opening Retreat and the Closing Dinner, the time commitment is eight full-day sessions. Attendance at the two day overnight Opening Retreat and Closing and at all sessions is required. If you miss a session, you may be subject to review by the LGB Steering Committee as to your eligibility for graduation from the program.

COMMUNITY PROJECTS:

In addition to the sessions, you will be asked to commit your time to a small group community project. The amount of time you will need to devote to the development of your project will be determined by consensus of your small group. Participation in the small group meetings is expected.

TUITION:

Leadership Green Bay's tuition is \$1,725. Employers generally pay all or most of the cost, but there are limited funds available for people who demonstrate a need for financial assistance. **Tuition is non-refundable once the program begins.**

SCHOLARSHIPS:
