Partners in Education Drug Alliance Fashion Show/Mr. Titletown Competition crowns Refsguard as Mr. Titletown

All contendees advanced to the Mr. Titletown Competition as a result of winning their respective schools’ “Mr. Man” competitions. Other participants included Ryan Henderson, Denmark High School, Michael Keim, Green Bay Preble, Jerrod McMonagle, De Pere High School, and Stan Wilinski, Green Bay West.

In addition, 29 female models from 11 area high schools and 13 male models from five area high schools participated in the annual formalwear show, modeling prom fashions and tuxedos for the current year.
